

## **DEPARTMENT 11 – YOUTH MARKET ANIMALS**

**Entry Deadline: June 15<sup>th</sup> of the current fair year**

**Entry Fee: \$1.50 per animal**

**Only 2 entries per Section per Exhibitor**

**Youth is anyone 2 - 18 years of age January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current fair year.**

**All Exhibitors are required to do Showmanship in each section entered.**

**There is no entry fee for showmanship.**

**All pens must be cleaned daily**

**All animals that are under-weight can be shown but WILL NOT be sold!!!**

**All exhibitors must have signage on pens including THANK YOU to last years buyers.**

**Grand Champion and Reserve Champion of each section must be sold. All market sale checks to seller/exhibitor will be issued 30 days after the close of the fair and not before.**

**Market Sale will include cockerels and capons from Department 8, and Meat Pen Rabbits from Department 9.**

**All sheep and goats must have a scrapie tag.**

**All health papers must be no older than 30 days.**

**Minimum weight in pounds:**

**Market hogs 210-300**

**Market lambs 60-160**

**Market goats 60**

**Beef Market Steers 900 (must not be 30 months old)**

**Premiums: 1<sup>st</sup> -- \$10 2<sup>nd</sup> -- \$8 3<sup>rd</sup> -- \$6 4<sup>th</sup> --\$4 5<sup>th</sup> --\$2**

### **SECTION A – MARKET HOGS**

#### **RULES:**

1. No swine showing clinical signs of any contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to any show.
2. All show swine must be individually identified by ear tags, notch or tattoo. Animals must show no signs of fresh ear notches.
3. Interstate swine exhibited at Pennsylvania fairs must meet the Pennsylvania requirements and must be accompanied by an interstate health certificate to be eligible for entry.
4. Exhibitor must indicate if animals are Paliene free or have been fed Paliene.

5. Must have self waterers for all market hogs

Individual Market Hogs farrowed after January 1<sup>st</sup>, of the current fair year.

1. Lightweight
2. Medium weight
3. Heavyweight

## **SECTION B – MARKET LAMBS**

1. All lambs in the Market Show/Sale must be born December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007 or later
2. All lambs must be tagged by a Fair Superintendent prior to entry
3. All lambs must be slick-shorn
4. Open to ewes or wethers, not rams
5. All ewe lambs must have a scrapie tag

1. All goats must have a tag or tattoo
2. Open to wethers and does.
3. Accepting goats with horns.
