

DEPARTMENT 15-Baked Goods, Canned & Preserved Products

Entry Deadline: June 15 of the current fair year

Entry Fees: 1-10 items \$1.25, 11-20 items \$2.50 and so on

RULES: In addition to the General Rules:

1. All products must have been made by the exhibitor. Premiums will not be paid for any commercial product.
2. Complete baked goods must be brought to the fair. After judging, the fair may display only a portion of the product for the fair event.
3. Baked goods become property of the fair.
4. All baked goods should be sealed in a clear plastic bag (allow to cool first) as the fair is an out-door event. Decorated cakes may be covered using a plastic wrap and toothpicks. All baked goods must be placed on a paper plate or cake board. Fair reserves the right to dispose of soiled products after judging is completed.
5. All classes in Department 15 have a junior division and an open division with premiums for each division. Each exhibitor may only enter in either the open division or the junior division within the department. The junior division is for youth 18 year of age or under on January 1, of the current fair year.

SECTION 1

BAKED GOODS - Junior and Senior Division

1. To be judged on flavor, lightness, general appearance, and crumb.
2. Absolutely no boxed mixes of any type will be permitted. Such exhibits may be disqualified.

SECTION 2

CANNED or DRIED GOODS

1. Entries should be in pint jars to prevent waste.
2. Canned foods are to be judged on general appearance, quality, container and taste
3. All jars will be opened and judged on taste. Care will be taken to close jars
4. Use standard Mason type; clear glass jars for preserving and exhibiting fruits, vegetables and meats.
5. Use two-piece, self-sealing lids (flat lids and metal straw bands) for sealing all jars of food.
6. Metal screw bands may be loosely applied while transporting jars to the fair to prevent damage, but must be present to reclose jars after judging.
7. Exhibitors name must not appear on jar.
