

## **DEPARTMENT 4 – SHEEP, WOOL & FIBER**

**Entry deadline: June 15<sup>th</sup> of the current fair year**

**Entry fee: \$1.25 per animal**

**\$0.50 per fleece**

**Rules: (In addition to General Rules)**

**Entries limited to 2 animals per class and 20 per farm or family**

**All Sheep must have a scrapie tag and have had a rabies vaccination. Proof of rabies vaccination must be presented at check-in.**

1. Current health papers and a Vet-Client Relationship form must be presented at check-in.
2. No sheep showing clinical signs, infectious or external parasitic disease, including foot rot and sore mouth will be admitted to the show.
3. All show sheep must be individually identified by an ear tag or tattoo, and this identification must be listed on the health certificate.
4. An accredited veterinarian shall examine the flock of origin, including sheep consigned to a show. The Vet. must prepare the original health certificate (BA-1-13) and must state on the health certificate that he examined the entire flock and found no evidence of contagious, infectious, or external parasitic disease. The date of examination must also appear on the health certificate. An interstate health certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian indicating that the entire flock was examined for health within 30 days must accompany all sheep from other states.
5. Pen of lambs consists of two ram and two ewe lambs.
6. Flock consists of one ram any age, two ewes one year and under two years old, two ewe lambs under one year.
7. Breeders' young flock consists of one ram lamb and two ewe lambs, all bred and owned by the exhibitor.
8. A Get of Sire shall consist of four (4) breeding animals, any age or sex, the get of one sire.
9. Animals six months of age and over are required to be registered in their respective breed association.
10. Animals under six months of age must be eligible for registry in their respective breed association.
11. PA Scrapie guidelines apply. All animals must be tagged with USDA approved scrapie tags identifying flock of origin.
