

## **DEPARTMENT 7 – LLAMAS/ALPACAS**

**Entry deadline: June 15, of the current fair year.**

**Entry fee: \$3.00 per animal**

**Rules:** in addition to the General Rules

1. All entry forms must be completed and legible. Incomplete forms will be returned.
2. Premiums will be paid in the following: **Halter 1<sup>st</sup> \$8, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$6, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$4, 4<sup>th</sup> \$3, and 5<sup>th</sup> ribbon.**
3. Animals will not be permitted on the midway before, during or after the show. Anyone found on the midway with livestock will be asked to remove the animal and themselves from the fairgrounds.
4. Health Regulations: Pennsylvania llamas and alpacas six (6) months and older must have a health certificate issued for the current show season.
5. Only one owner or exhibitor per entry form. There may be multiple animals on each entry form.
6. Fleece information and rules are located in Department 4, Sheep and Wool/Fibers.
7. All fleece show entries must be properly labeled with the name of the exhibitor. Fleece entries must be owned by the exhibitor. An exhibitor is permitted to enter only two (2) fleece entries in each category.
8. All handmade items must have been made by the exhibitor since the conclusion of last years fair. Only one entry per exhibitor per class.
9. All fleece and handmade items are due at the fairgrounds by 1:00 PM Sunday July 6, 2008. No entries will be taken the day of the show.
10. Disputes will be governed by the current edition ALSA handbook and the fair rules and regulations.

### **HALTER CLASS**

LIGHT AND MEDIUM WOOL CLASSES -- llamas that are either light or medium woolen may compete in these classes. Light wool: minimal body wool with a smooth head, ears, and legs. Medium wool: moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate head and leg wool.

- C1. Light/Medium Wool – Male under 2 years as of show date
- C2. Light/Medium Wool --Male 2 years and over as of show date
- C3. Light/Medium Wool – Female under 2 years of age as of show date
- C4. Light/Medium Wool – Female 2 years and over as of show date

HEAVY WOOL CLASSES – Heavy wool: abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant head and leg wool (i.e. leg wool at least to knee and hock).

- C5. Heavy Wool – Male under 2 years as of show date
- C6. Heavy Wool – Male 2 years and over as of show date
- C7. Heavy Wool – Female under 2 years as of show date

C8. Heavy Wool – Female 2 years and over as of show date

C9. Open Alpaca – Male under 2 years as of show date

C10. Open Alpaca – Male 2 years and over as of show date

C11. Open Alpaca – Female under 2 years as of show date
