Entry Deadline: June 30th

ENTRY FEE: \$4.00 per animal and \$1.00 per event, list events entered on Entry Form.

Rules: (In addition to General Rules)

No Equine showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to any show or other fair event.

- **HEALTH CERTIFICATE (AA1-13 PA Dept. of Agriculture Certificate) MUST ACCURATELY IDENTIFY THE ANIMAL AND MUST INCLUDE REQUIRED SHOTS.**
 - All health papers will be checked before unloading.
 - All health papers must be issued after June 1st.
 - A Vet-Client Relationship Form must accompany Health Papers at check-in and will remain in the fair office for one (1) year as required by the State.
 - All horses must have a current rabies vaccination and have proof of vaccination by a licensed Veterinarian at check-in.
 - Exhibitors must present proof of Equine Infectious Anemia Test with the results and test date at check-in.
 - Coggins is required again.
- You must pre-enter (NOT FOR OPEN SHOW) and have your entries sent in as stated on the application. Rider may be limited one horse per rider in event of overflowing the barn.
- NO STALLION will be accepted for entry to fairgrounds of show.
- NO PREGNANT MARES will be accepted.
- Animals on grounds must be entered and shown.
- In no case is it permissible to show more than one breed in the same halter class or division to be judged against each other for the premiums except for supreme champion class.
- All entries must do showmanship.
- Rules, regulations and patterns will be at the judges' discretion and will be announced before each class.
- Judges and Superintendents may add additional classes as they see fit, but **NO PREMIUM WILL BE PAYABLE ON THESE CLASSES.**
- Stall decorations will be judged. Equine information must be on display.
- All horses **MUST** remain in stalls during fair hours with the exception of horse shows and animal dressing.
- Sitting on horses in stalls is **NOT** permitted.
- Open arena time for riding will be posted on the white board located in the front of the horse barn.
- Each rider must present a signed liability waiver found in the back of the Premium Book.
- All riders under 18 **MUST** wear a helmet while mounted.
