SECTION A - 4-H DOG SHOW

Superintendent: Melanie Ribblet

Entry Deadline: June 30, 2024

ENTRY FEE: \$4.00 per dog. **No Fee for Pee-Wee (Use Livestock entry form.)**

RULES: (in addition to General Rules)

- A current rabies vaccination is required for all exhibition dogs three (3) months of age and older. All vaccine label directions must be followed, and the final dose of vaccine must be administered at least 15 days prior to entry into the exhibition. All rabies vaccinated dogs must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate which must contain information fields consistent with the current version of the National Association of State Public Health Veterinarians Rabies Compendium (including, but not limited to, animal identification, breed, sex, age and color; the vaccination tag number; the vaccine name, lot number, duration of immunity, and manufacturer, and the date of the vaccination), and must be accurately and legibly completed the certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine. A copy of the rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.
- A current PA Dog License is required and verified by certificate or tag.
- An Animal Owner or Caretaker’s Verification of Veterinarian Client Patient Relationship (VCPR) statement for the animals being exhibited must be included on the fair registration form.
- All entries will be required to show in their respective grooming, showmanship and obedience classes; except when a dog is in season and may be shown in grooming and showmanship classes but not in obedience.
- The following rules pertain to dogs entered in the agility class which possibly include obstacles like bar jump, panel jump, double and triple jump, tire jump, tunnels, chute and weave poles:
 - a. Dogs must be 15 months old, the day of the Round Up.
 - b. Dogs must be shown in a flat, buckle collar with no tags or dangling objects.
 - c. Dogs must enter/exit ring on leash.
 - d. All runs will be timed and will only be used in case of a tie.
 - e. Jump heights are based on the shoulder height of the dog:

Less than 11 inches	8 inches
Less than 14 inches	12 inches
Less than 18 inches	16 inches
Less than 22 inches	20 inches

- A member may exhibit two rockets but only one entry per class
- No live engines.

PREMIUMS: 1st - \$5.00, 2nd – \$4.50, 3rd – \$4.00

1. Skill Level I – Age 8 – 11

- Bottle Rocket – Display
- Bottle Rockets are to be designed using only 2-liter bottles described in the “4-H Rockets Away” Booklet.
- To be eligible for altitude and accuracy classes, rockets must have been exhibited in a construction class.
- Members must be present to launch rocket and need to provide appropriate type engine.
- Member may only enter one altitude class
- Altitude and accuracy will be evaluated with one launch

SECTION C – 4-H ARCHERY

Entry Deadline: June 30, 2024

ENTRY FEE: \$2.00

RULES:

- This is a skill competition and awards will be based on scoring from six (6) arrows show at each of three distances based on class entered.
- No written test is required.
- Participants must be members of 4-H archery program
- Participants and parents/guardians must sign a liability weaver before beginning the competition
- Each competitor must supply their own equipment.

EQUIPMENT PERMITTED

- Long bows, recurve, and compound – CROSSBOWS ARE NOT PERMITTED
- Sights, stabilizers, cable guides and mechanical releases
- Arrows can be made from any materials. All arrows must be equipment with field points
- Broad head are not permitted
- All archers are to bring a minimum of six (6) arrows to competition. Please bring spare equipment in case of any equipment failure.
- A tie will be broken by a shoot-off from farthest distance
- Range rules will be announced prior to start of the shoot.
- Competition will be based off of a shoot-off FITA targets, 3-D and field targets. Six (6) targets for each.
- Scoring will be based off of IBO scoring.

CLASSES

1. Junior Division 8 – 10 year olds will shoot 10, 15, and 20 yards
2. Intermediate Division 11-13 year olds will shoot 15, 20, and 30 yards
3. Senior Division 14-19 year olds will shoot 35, 45, and 55 yards
