**Entry Deadline:** June 30, 2025

**ENTRY FEE:** \$3.50 per animal

\$2.00 per class except Showmanship & Breed

**YOUTH AND OPEN ENTRIES.** Must pay two (2) entry fees if entering both classes.

**RULES:** (In addition to General Rules)

- Entries limited to 20 animals per farm or family.
- No goat showing clinical signs of infectious or external parasitic disease, including foot rot and sore mouth will be admitted to the show.
- Animals under six months of age must be eligible for registry in their respective breed association.
- PA Scrapie guidelines apply. All animals must carry an approved Scrapie ID identifying herd of origin.
- There will not be stalling for animals that are not entered.

**PREMIUMS:** 1<sup>st</sup> - \$8.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$6.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$4.00

one animal in this class. Each exhibitor should be prepared to explain to judge the goat's purpose.
