SECTION B – ANIMAL DRESSING

A fun exhibition of fair entries and their handler.

1. Contestant and animal choose a costume or theme.
2. Each entry will parade around the show ring and perform.
3. Awards are given for a vast variety of areas.
4. Ribbons and prizes are awarded to each handler after the animal is returned to its housing area.
5. Entries may be a single, double, or group of contestants.
6. Safety is priority, but fun and creativity are highly encouraged.

Registration is the night of the event, but closes 15 minutes prior to the show.

SHOW BEGINS 6:00 PM THURSDAY JULY 18th

SECTION C – QUAD RODEO (Register day of event)

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per rider for Battery Powered class.
\$10.00 per Gas Class per rider.

PREMIUMS: Place ribbons, some contests have monetary prizes as noted.

RULES:

- A rider may register more than one quad. Multiple riders may register the same quad.
- Upon arrival each rider must register and sign a “liability Wavier/Release Form”. Any rider under age 18 must have parent/guardian signature.
- All competitors must attend the riders meeting prior to the event.
- Riders must wear a helmet and riding/work boot. Eye protection and gloves are recommended.
- Operators only. No passengers.
- Quad must be mechanically sound. Anything deemed unsafe by the officials will result in the quad not being able to compete.
- All quads and equipment must remain in the pit area. No one is permitted to ride on the grounds except in designated areas. Any breaking of these rules will result in an automatic disqualification and removal from event, and there are NO REFUNDS!
- Officials may alter rules or the course of the event as deemed necessary.
- Officials’ decisions are final.
- NO 3 WHEELERS, DIRTBIKES OR SIDExSIDES PERMITTED.
- In the battery operated classes, a parent or guardian may be present in the area. All other classes, rider is on their own.

***** DAMAGE to property will result in immediate DISQUALIFICATION and removal from the fairgrounds!**

SECTION D – DTAF DEAD WEIGHT FARM TRACTOR PULL (Register day of event)

HOOK-UP FEE: \$10.00 per tractor per class

Three (3) Trophies per class

3,000 – Outlaw Weigh-in: See schedule

RULES:

- After tractor is checked and weighted in, it will be placed in a designated holding area. No more weights can be added.
- The driver that is pulling for the trophy must be the driver that weights in the tractor.
- Tractors will be numbered by use of random pull from a bingo machine at the time of registration. The tractors will pull in numerical order.
- Current Class and on deck class only to be in the area.
- Tractor and two (2) people only in the arena after weigh in.
- Tractors are limited two (2) drivers per tractor. First driver is for trophy, second driver is for fun.
- A pull consists of a 15 foot pull with two (2) chances to make 15 feet. (Both tries will be added together to make 15 feet.)
- Sled will be pulled in one direction and pulled back to a designated point by a pullback tractor.
- When the flagman drops the flag the tractor must stop.
- Safety rules are at the discretion of the judges (i.e. front end lifting in an unsafe manner).
- Weights can be transferred from one point of the tractor to another.
- NO RIDERS or HITCHHIKERS on the tractor at any time.
- All drivers must be a minimum age of 12 years to 18 years of age and have written permission from parents or guardian upon entry.
- NO children in arena during event under 12 years old.
- If any weights or parts of the tractor fall off during the pull it will be disqualified.
- If pulling off of a 3-point hitch, it must be maintained at 18 inches or under.
- NO FAST DRIVING.
- Tractors must have basic stock appearance
- No jerking the sled. Chain on the sled must be tight.
- There will be out of bounds lines marked with chalked tractors must not cross this line.
- Judges decision is final.
- Must have all wheels and tires on tractor! Must be complete.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Hitch height – 18 inches maximum.
2. Hitch length – minimum of 18 inches from center of axle

3. Wheel weights are allowed on the surface of the wheel.
4. Front weight rack cannot be more than 3 feet from the grill.
5. Tractors must have a working governor.
6. NO TIRE CHAINS
7. NO DUAL WHEELS – except Outlaw Classes
8. NO STEEL WHEELS
9. Steel press and aluminum wheels are allowed.

– GARDEN TRACTOR General Rules

The below listed rules are structured to allow both beginners and advanced Pullers to be competitive. Any questions please see me in person. Rules are Rules Ladies and Gentlemen, at the end of the day our goal is to consider everyone part of our pulling family, friends and to have fun. These rules will be in effect for 2023-2026.

Rules may change based on safety.

1. All decisions made by track official(s) are final; Any arguing with the ruling of the official(s) may result in disqualification.
2. All tractors participating must have a working kill switch to ground out the ignition. This will be checked at the scales and a non-working kill switch will result in no pulling until it has been fixed (must be easily accessible)
3. All tractors must have roll over protection (wheelie bars) that extend 5 inches behind the rear tires and can't be more than 5 inches off the ground.
4. All hitches must be in plain view and must have a 1.5-inch hole for chain. Hitches with all-thread must have nuts securing the top and bottom plate. Must remain stationary in all directions. Hook chain cannot touch wheelie bars
5. All tractors must have a wheelbase of 54 inches and have stock appearing hood, grill, dash, and fenders
6. All tractors must have safety shielding covering all moving parts such as belts, pulleys, crankshaft, and any clutch parts. All shielding must be made of at least 1/16 steel or 3/16 aluminum. No tractor will be allowed to pull without proper shielding.
7. Wheel weights are allowed as long as no all-thread is sticking out past the wheels.
8. All tractors must have a seat with a back on it.
9. Front weight booms can't extend over 6 feet from the center of the rear axle.
10. All engines in a stock class must meet all factory specs!
 - *Working governor.
 - *Stock, un-ground camshaft that came with that model engine.
 - *Stock un-modified carb that came with that engine.
 - *Carb must have choke plate in it.
 - *Stock timing-no aftermarket ignition.
 - *Stock valves, valve springs, and piston for that model engine.
 - *Stock head (NO RECAST HEADS)
 - *Stock unbalanced crankshaft and crank bearings, (no mini bearings.)
 - *Must have stock fuel system. No regulator.
 - *No carb spacers
 - *Aftermarket piston rods are allowed but must be stock length, (no offset bearings or long rods).
 - *The engines can be bored .030 inches over, have the head shaved port and polish before the valves, (this applies only to single cylinder and flat head twin engines)
 - *Adult 12 hp & 16 hp will allow a .330 lift cam. Must run stock carb & valve train.

11. All classes may run a steel flywheel for safety but must be stock timed. No weighted front pullies.
12. All V-twin engines in the stock class must be factory stock. No modifications of any kind except air cleaners and stock timed steel flywheels. Solid Lifters and Adjustable Push Rods permitted. No adjustable rockers.
13. No oxygenated fuel in any class
14. Track officials have the right to disqualify anyone operating a tractor in an unsafe manner on or off the track.
15. No alcoholic beverages
16. Anyone walking on the track with a driver in the kids' class must always remain at a safe distance.
17. All drivers must have a DOT approved helmet for all classes. All drivers in the Open, Hot Stock, or Diesel classes must wear a fire suit. As per insurance Regulations
18. Only two hooks per tractor. Only exceptions are an adult pulling a Kids class tractor or Powder Puff.
19. Once the sign-up sheet has been taken to the track, that class is closed for sign-ups.
20. Tech officials have the right to inspect any tractor if they feel it's illegal in any way. Refusing the inspection is an automatic disqualification from the class and loss of points for the previous pulls. If the tractor is found legal, all gaskets or parts damaged will be replaced. All inspections will be done in a closed area with only the driver and 2 tech officials present. Tech officials ruling is final.
21. Two people can protest a tractor to be inspected. You must put the drivers name and what class tractor to be inspected in an envelope with \$150 cash (\$200 Twin Cyl.) and present it to tech officials along with reasons you are protesting. The tractor in question will be checked at that event. If the tractor is illegal, the money will be reimbursed. If the tractor is legal, the driver gets to keep the money. Must be a part of the same class to protest! Points are lost to illegal tractors.
22. All stock tractors must have reverse
23. Driver meeting every day.
24. Objects falling off a tractor during your pull are grounds for disqualification. (Not an automatic DQ) Track official will make determination based on safety and did it advance pullers distance. Most cases hinder and not help a tractor.

- 23x10.50x12 maximum tire size
- Fire suit required
- Run what you brung! (RWYB)
- 13-inch hitch height
- 950 lbs. and 1000 lbs.
- 40 cubic inch limit

Sport Stock V Twin

- Open RPM
- 25 hp engine
- Stock stroke

- Stock un-modified pistons. (No flat top pistons)
- .020 inch over bore max.
- OEM heads - No welding
- Billet rods allowed
- Stock rocker arms
- Stock valve diameter and length
- Stock intake (cast or plastic)
- Down draft carbs only, no 2 barrel or k-series carb
- Steel flywheel mandatory
- Stock ignition (no crank trigger)
- 1050 lbs. and 1150 lbs.

Large tire open

- 26x12x12 tire size
- Fire suits mandatory
- Run what you bring !
- 1000 lbs. and 1050 lbs.

V-Twin Stock Altered

- Engines: Must be commercially available lawn and/or garden tractor engine. 25 HP engine allowed.
- 44 cubic inch max.
- Cylinder head: Must be stock head with no external welding. Epoxy is okay. No valve restrictions. No inverting the heads. (Stock appearing)
- No limit on camshaft.
- OEM crankshaft.
- Cleanup on top of block is okay.
- Downdraft stock appearing carb.
- Stock plastic/cast intake only.
- Steel flywheel mandatory.
- Spark plug to remain in stock location.
- Air cleaner or velocity stack is allowed.
- Electronic fuel pump is allowed.
- Wheelbase: 56 inches max. front weight boom. limit is 8 ft front center of rear axle.
- Gas only. No oxygenated fuel or methanol.
- No head studs, no welding of the block.
- Any ignition allowed.
- 1100 lbs. and 1150 lbs.
- All other general rules apply.

- Clipper Class: No Modified tractors, must be as manufactured
- 12 hp Kids (stock): 850 & 950 lbs. 12" Hitch. Must pull with the club 3 times through out the year to be eligible for Shootout cash prizes.

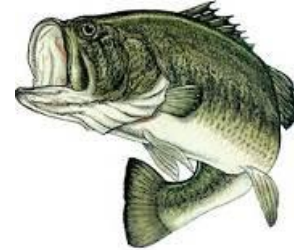
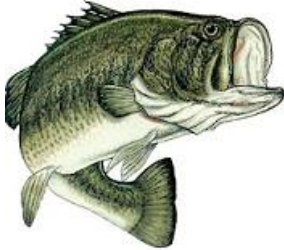
- 12 hp Adult (stock): 875 & 975 lbs. 12" Hitch
- Small Tire RWYB: 950 & 1000 lbs. 13" Hitch
- 16 hp (stock): 1000 & 1100, 12" Hitch
- 20 hp Flat head twin (stock): 1050 & 1150 lbs. 12" Hitch
- 20 hp V-Twin (stock): 1100 & 1200 lbs. 12" Hitch
- V-Twin Sport Stock: 1050 & 1150 lbs. 13" Hitch

BASS TOURNAMENT RULES

1. No more than one (1) line in the water at any time and it must be attended at all times.
2. The contest will be limited to the first 50 paying entries received. No entry fee, no entry allowed.
3. This tournament is for fun – anyone being belligerent or obnoxious will be disqualified and asked to leave. No refund of the entry fee will be given.
4. Only artificial lures will be used. No baiting of fish will be permitted.
5. All entries will be assigned into 1 of 4 groups. You must stay with that group. The groups will rotate clockwise one area every hour so all groups can fish all areas of the pond.
6. No horseplay. Be careful of casting and who may be behind you.
7. Fishing will be from the bank only – no waders, no boats.
8. Be aware of your neighbor and his line. If your neighbor is pulling in a fish you should pull in your line so tangles do not occur.
9. Remember fish want to live also – anyone caught ripping hooks from a fish's mouth will be disqualified. We would rather see you destroy your lure than hurt the fish.
10. Water can be as deep as 10 feet – be aware of the possibility of drowning. Take precautions and wear safety equipment if necessary. Scoring will be done as follows: Weight will be the determining factor. If a tie exists, length will then be the next consideration. If a tie exists after weight and length are determined, then the prize money for the existing prize placing will be totaled and divided equally among the tied anglers.
11. There will be no fishing off or around the dock. Casting near or under the dock will not be tolerated.
12. We prefer that fish be returned to the pond so that this can stay an annual event. This pond will not be restocked.
13. Eating is permitted but pick up your garbage. **Alcohol will not be allowed.**
14. Ruling of the presiding officials will be final.
15. Prizes will be as listed above if there are 50 received.
16. A minimum of 25 entries must be made, otherwise only payout on 1st Place.
17. Prizes will be awarded for bass only. Only one (1) prize awarded per person.
18. Fishing will begin at 7:00 AM and finish at 11:00 AM.
19. Premium payout will be mailed.
