Entry Deadline: June 30th

ENTRY FEE: \$3.50 per animal
\$2.00 per class except Showmanship & Breed

YOUTH AND OPEN ENTRIES. Must pay two entry fees if entering both classes.

RULES: (In addition to General Rules)

- Entries limited to 20 animals per farm or family.
- Current health papers and a Vet-Client Relationship form must be presented at check-in. CVI must be issued after May 1 of the current year.
- No goat showing clinical signs of infectious or external parasitic disease, including foot rot and sore mouth will be admitted to the show.
- All show goats must be individually identified by an ear tag or tattoo, and this identification must be listed on the health certificate.
- Animals under six months of age must be eligible for registry in their respective breed association.
- PA Scrapie guidelines apply. All animals must carry an approved Scrapie ID identifying herd of origin.
- There will not be stalling for animals that are not entered.

SECTION N - UTILITY GOAT

- Any goat that cannot be shown in any other class, may be doe or wether. Goat should have a purpose: cart goat, pack goat, companion goat. Each exhibitor may only show one animal in this class. Each exhibitor should be prepared to explain to judge the goat's purpose.

1. Goat under 2
2. Goat 2 and over
