**ENTRY FEE:** \$3.50 per animal

\$2.00 per class except Showmanship & Breed

\$2.00 per fleece

**YOUTH AND OPEN ENTRIES** -Must pay two (2) entry fees if entering both classes

**RULES:** (In addition to General Rules)

- Entries limited to two (2) animals per class and 20 per farm/family.
- Current health papers and a Vet-Client Relationship form must be presented at checkin. CVI must be issued after May 1.
- No sheep showing clinical signs of infectious or external parasitic disease, including foot rot and sore mouth, will be admitted to the show.
- All sheep must be individually identified by an ear tag or tattoo and this identification must be listed on the health certificate.
- Pen of lambs consists of two (2) ram and two (2) ewe lambs.
- Flock consists of one (1) ram any age, two (2) ewes one year and under two years old, and two (2) ewe lambs under one (1) year of age.
- Breeders' young flock consists of one (1) ram lamb and two (2) ewe lambs, all bred and owned by the exhibitor.
- A Get of Sire shall consist of four (4) breeding animals, any age or sex, the get of one sire.
- Animals six (6) months of age and over are required to be registered in their respective breed association.
- Animals under six months of age must be eligible for registry in their respective breed association.
- PA Scrapie guidelines apply. All animals must carry an approved Scrapie ID identifying flock of origin or proof of registration with legible tattoo.
- There will not be stalling for animals that are not entered.
